



jeppe hein: modified social benches I-u beaufort04, de haan wenduine, belgium on now until september 30th, 2012

jeppe hein has installed a selection of his 'modified social benches I-u' by the seaside in de haan wenduine, belgium, the danish artist has created a playful interpretation of an entirely average seating implement. the ordinary outdoor, public benches have had their seats redefined by hein, as the space in which one would typically rest has been altered to a state upon which the viewer may not normally recline, the artist developed these works to evoke from the viewer an unexpected response from communication with an expected object, each of the pieces have been situated on the the dyke of de haan, their natural placement by the seaside follows the pedestrian path, bringing to the space an interactive element to which the site's regular passersby did not expect to see.

'modified social benches I-u' is on show in de haan wenduine, belgium as part of the 2012 edition of beaufort04: fourth triennial of contemporary art by the sea.
